Notes for choosing modules:

Please note that students taking a student loan may be subject to requirements for length of time of study and number of modules taken in an academic year. Please check loan conditions carefully.

Students who follow a specialist option, for example Pastoral Care, must choose 2 modules in total within that specialism. The third module can be chosen within or outside the specialism, and the fourth is normally Research Methods, followed by Dissertation.

Notes for the MEd Literacy Pathway:

For this pathway students must complete modules one at a time and follow a particular order of modules. All modules must be completed. Loan students MUST complete in 3 years: Year 1 EDC9093 Semester 1 followed by EDC9094 in Semester 2. Year 2 EDC7024 in Semester 1 followed by EDC7069 in Semester 2. Year 3 for Dissertation. Please note additional assessments on these modules.

Self-funded students, can complete over a minimum of 3 years or can complete over a longer period of time (up to 5 years). Dissertation can be completed with or without AMBDA assessment and this can be decided in final year.

In Semester one (and until further notice) all modules will be taught via the College virtual learning environment Canvas or in some instances Abode connect or Moodle. Students must ensure they have the correct technology requirements and that these are in place before the beginning of your course, in particular a strong broadband connection, and good working computer.
