I can't see colour,

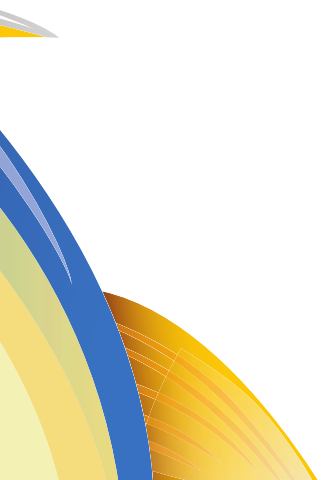
I can't see life,
